- How did they make houses?

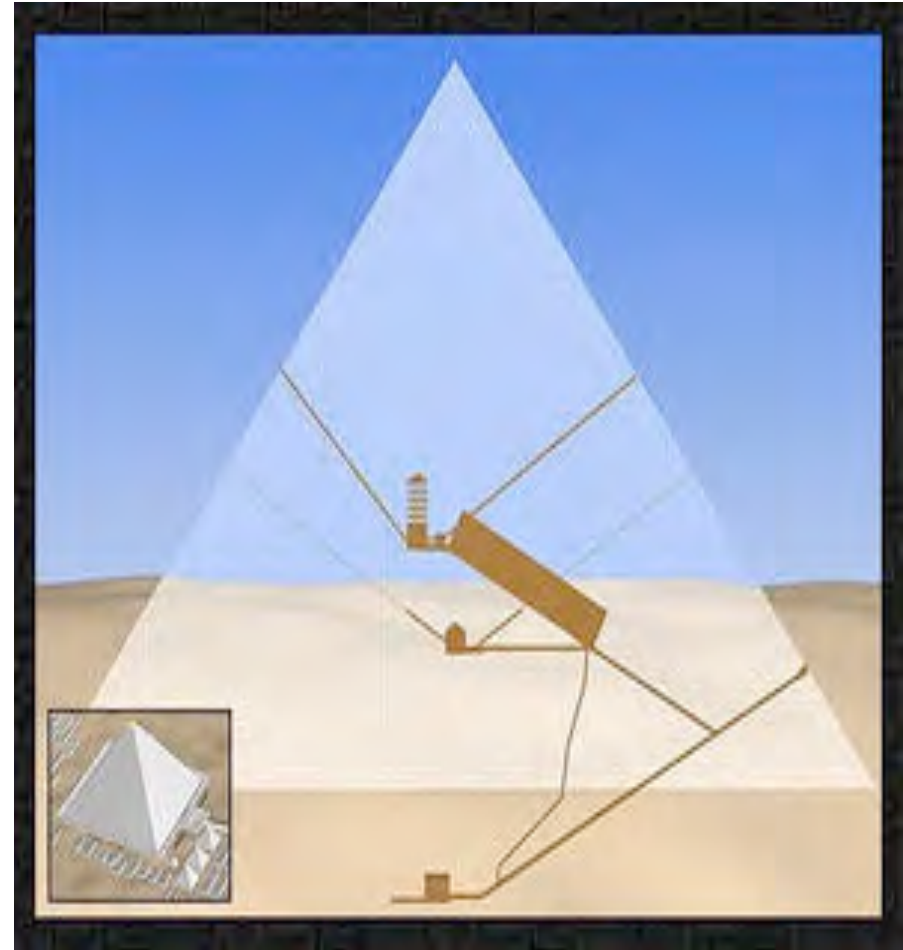
How did they make temples?
