- The farmers and the Nile

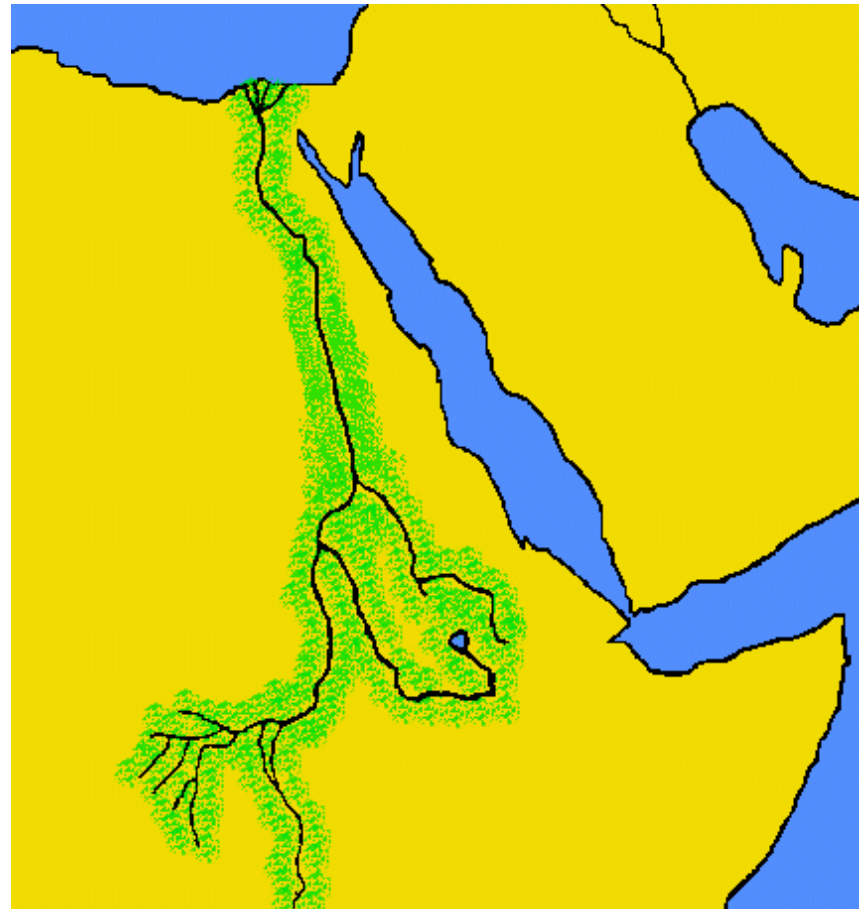
Hapi, the god of the Nile

- Meet in Sudan Khartoum



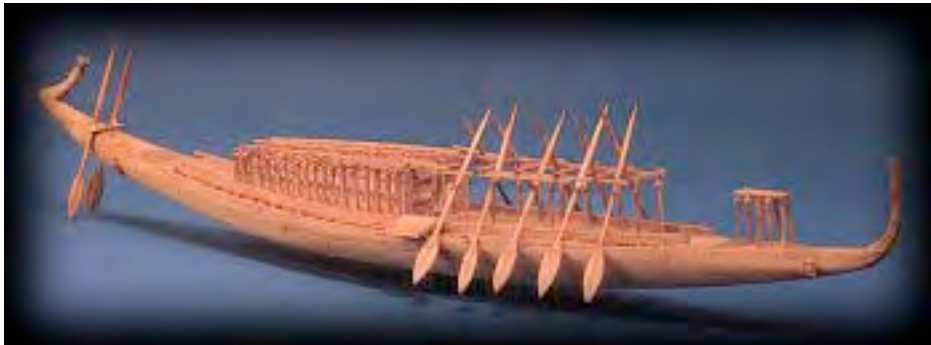
The farmers and the Nile
