Dear Parents,

I am very much looking forward to welcoming your children into Prep M. Prior to commencing the school year there is some very useful information I would like to share with you.

Please find below a list of essential items your child will need to bring to school at the start of year.

- 1 school bag for daily use
- 1 folder
- 1 box of felt tip pens (Giotto turbo) thick or thin
- 1 box of coloured pencils
- 4 erasers (plain rectangular)
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 6 writing pencils (HB)
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of full size tissues
- 1 packet of wet wipes
- 1 art apron
- 1 full change of clothes (labeled and bagged to remain at school)

Lessons begin promptly at 0900; students should have unpacked prior to this to ensure a timely start. The start of the school day is an extremely important time and should not be missed unnecessarily. Students (not using the school buses) should be collected from the E.C. garden at the end of the day between 1500 and 1530 or from the atrium from 1530 to 1540.

Students will be offered a snack provided by the school at morning break, however, parents may send snacks to school with students. The school recommends healthy snacks only. Should your child bring his/her own lunch to school he/she must be able to eat independently (be able to open containers etc.). Containers made of glass or other easily broken materials should not be sent to school.

Prep M. will have P.E. (Physical Education) on Monday, Tuesday and Friday each week. Please ensure your child comes to school dressed appropriately to participate in the activities.

There will be a meeting for parents during the week from 19th - 23rd September. There will be lots of additional information to share as well as the chance to discuss any other matters.
